Only sealed glass, metal and plastic containers are included.

Beer, soda, and water containers are still included.

Wine, Mead, and Distilled Spirits Milk (dairy and plant based) Infant Formula Meal-Replacement Drinks Concentrated Cocktail Mixers

Foil pouches, cartons, and drink boxes, along with metal containers requiring a tool to be opened, i.e. a can opener, are non-redeemable.
